For the Month Ending August 31, 2010

HOA Funds are held in the following accounts:

\$ 47,218.00	in our Operating Account
\$ 364,495.00	invested in various CD's and CDAR's
\$ 250,371.00	in Reserve Accounts
\$ 161,327.00	is owed to the HOA by residents.

Twenty nine (29) have been sold in the community this year to date. Seventy (70) homes currently have legal action pending. There are one-hundred-fourteen (114) known rented homes in the community.

The Home Owners Association took possession of two (2) homes this summer. One has gone back to the bank, while the other is still in the possession of the HOA.
